Affected Airspace:

Mali airspace, Niamey FiR (DRRR), at altitudes below 24 000 feet (ft) above ground level (AGL).

Applicability:

This CZIB applies to operators.

Description:

This CZIB is issued on the basis of information available to EU Member States and EU institutions. The presence of terrorist groups with the necessary capabilities (including anti-aircraft weaponry) is assessed to pose a HIGH risk to operations within the portion of the Niamey FIR which is situated above Mali territory, at altitudes below 24 000 ft AGL.

Recommendation(s):

Operators should take this information and any other relevant information into account in their own risk assessments, alongside any available guidance or directions from their national authority as appropriate.

Validity:

This CZIB is valid until 28 February 2018.

A. APPLICABILITY. THIS NOTAM APPLIES TO: ALL U.S. AIR CARRIERS AND COMMERCIAL OPERATORS; ALL PERSONS EXERCISING THE PRIVILEGES OF AN AIRMAN CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE FAA, EXCEPT SUCH PERSONS OPERATING U.S.-REGISTERED AIRCRAFT FOR A FOREIGN AIR CARRIER; AND ALL OPERATORS OF AIRCRAFT REGISTERED IN THE UNITED STATES, EXCEPT WHERE THE OPERATOR OF SUCH AIRCRAFT IS A FOREIGN AIR CARRIER.

B. PLANNING. C. OPERATIONS. EXERCISE CAUTION DURING FLIGHT OPERATIONS DUE TO THE POSSIBILITY OF ATTACKS ON CIVIL AVIATION BY EXTREMISTS/MILITANTS.
