Dear Prof. Dr. Yuksek,

The Department of State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation presents its compliments to the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Turkey and you personally, we would like to address with following proposal.

We would like to offer you through an exchange of letters to consolidate a temporary agreement for 2 consecutive IATA Seasons, starting from IATA Summer-2021, to increase the number of designated air carriers on the route Moscow – Antalya v.v. to 5 (five) air carries for each Side, with the limitation of 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the fifth designated air carrier of each Side.

In case of your agreement, we propose that this letter and your positive response to it to be considered as a temporary agreement between our Aeronautical Authorities.

The proposed agreement will be temporary and may be suspended in the event of deterioration of the sanitary and epidemiological situation with a corresponding notice.

Due to the instability of the situation with the spread of a new coronavirus infection and uncertainty about the market situation after the removal of restrictions on COVID-19, we believe it is possible to continue negotiations on extension of commercial rights on a permanent basis after the improvement of the sanitary and epidemiological situation.

We hope to continue mutually beneficial cooperation.
