PROTOCOL:

Delegations representing the Aeronautical Authorities of the Hashemite Kingdom of

Jordan and the Russian Federation met in Colombo on 7th December 2017 to discuss air

transport matters of mutual interest.

List of Delegations is attached hereto at Appendix I.

1. The discussions were held in a friendly and constructive atmosphere. Both sides

discussed the following issues:

2. Both Delegations held their discussions on further development of the existing

operational conditions between their respective countries. Both Delegations agreed that the

designated airlines of each Party shall be entitled to operate the agreed services with up to

seven (7) weekly frequencies on each city pair on the agreed routes in accordance to the

Annex of ASA in force.

3. Both Delegations agreed that any passenger and/or combination and/or all-cargo

Jordan air carriers shall have the right to perform flights to Sochi for the three IATA

seasons starting from Winter 2017-2018, with 3%, 4% and 5% freedom traffic rights.

without any limitation, provided that these operations do not utilize the Transsiberian

route. This regime may be prolonged with the separate decision of the Russian

Aeronautical Authorities.

4. Both Delegations agreed that designated as well as non-designated passenger and/or

combination and/or all-cargo air carriers of the Russian Federation shall have the right to

perform flights to Agaba with 3rd, 4th and 5th freedom traffic rights, without any limitation.
