Dear Mr Tasun,

I am pleased to inform you that the French carrier EUROPE AIRPOST will operate scheduled agreed services to/from Samara.

I would like therefore to inform you that, in accordance with article 3 of the Agreement related to Air Services between the Government of the French republic and the Government of the Federation of Russia dated 2 July 2001, EUROPE AIRPOST shall be the French designated airline on the route Paris – Samara (v.v). The corresponding designation diplomatic note shall be sent in the following days through the diplomatic network.

Additionally, in accordance with paragraph 1.2.1.a) of the Confidential Memorandum dated 4 July 2001, as modified by the Confidential Protocol of Negotiations dated 21 January 2005, the French Aeronautical Authorities hereby officially nominate the point of Samara (KUF) in Russia as one of the three roving points on French Route 1 to be freely selected by the French Authorities.
